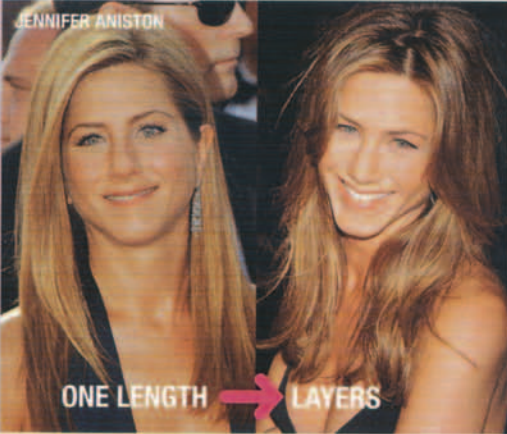

HOW TO DO THE DO

To achieve this wavy look, use a mixture of gel and styling lotion. You'll get the perfect amount of hold but still keep your hair feeling soft and natural. Put a dime-size amount of each in your palm and rub hands together. Apply to damp hair and dry with a diffuser. Try combining Alberto VO5 Real Clean Styling Gel, \$3.49, and Tresemmé Tres Create Styling Putty, \$3.99.



JENNIFER

Jennifer knew she wanted a new look, but she still wanted to feel like herself. Senior stylist and colorist Shin thought dramatic layers with a sweeping bang was the perfect way to transform her style without getting too crazy. She focused on keeping the length and just giving Jennifer a new shape that allowed for more movement.

Shin highlighted Jennifer's hair to accentuate the cut. She used a new technique called under-lighting that involves lightening only pieces that are under the top layer of hair, for a subtle but stunning effect. The under-lights allow Jennifer to get touchups less frequently.



STRAIGHTEN OUT!

ERNIE McCRAW, DIRECTOR OF BEAUTY EDUCATION FOR SALLY BEAUTY, MAKES STRAIGHTENING YOUR HAIR EASY WITH THESE THREE STEPS:

- 1 After hair is clean and dry, apply a heat protection product that will keep the hair cuticle smooth and will boost your hair's moisture retention. We suggest Charles Worthington Results Perfectly Straight Straightening Iron Protection Spray, \$5.99.
- 2 Divide hair into three sections: top, left side and right side. Working from front to back, take small sections of hair and move the iron in one fluid motion from roots to ends. Do not let the iron sit in one place too long, as the heat can damage the hair. Ernie suggests an iron from Jilbere de Paris.
- 3 Comb out hair and apply a gloss to keep hair straight and shiny for longer. We suggest Kenra Platinum Silkening Gloss, \$15. ★
