

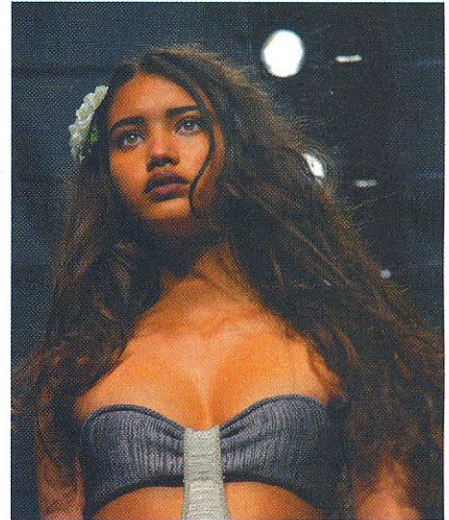

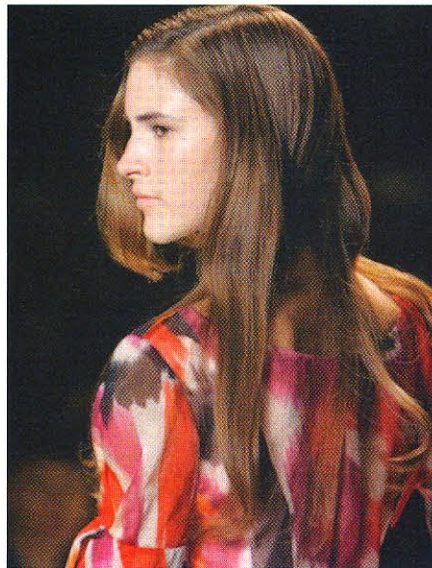


Omar Lopez led the GHD Directive Team for Ashley Paige at LA Fashion Week. The overall look was all about romance and poetry, with curls, waves and movement.

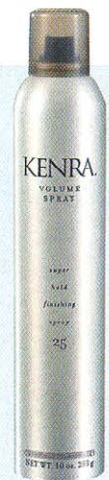
