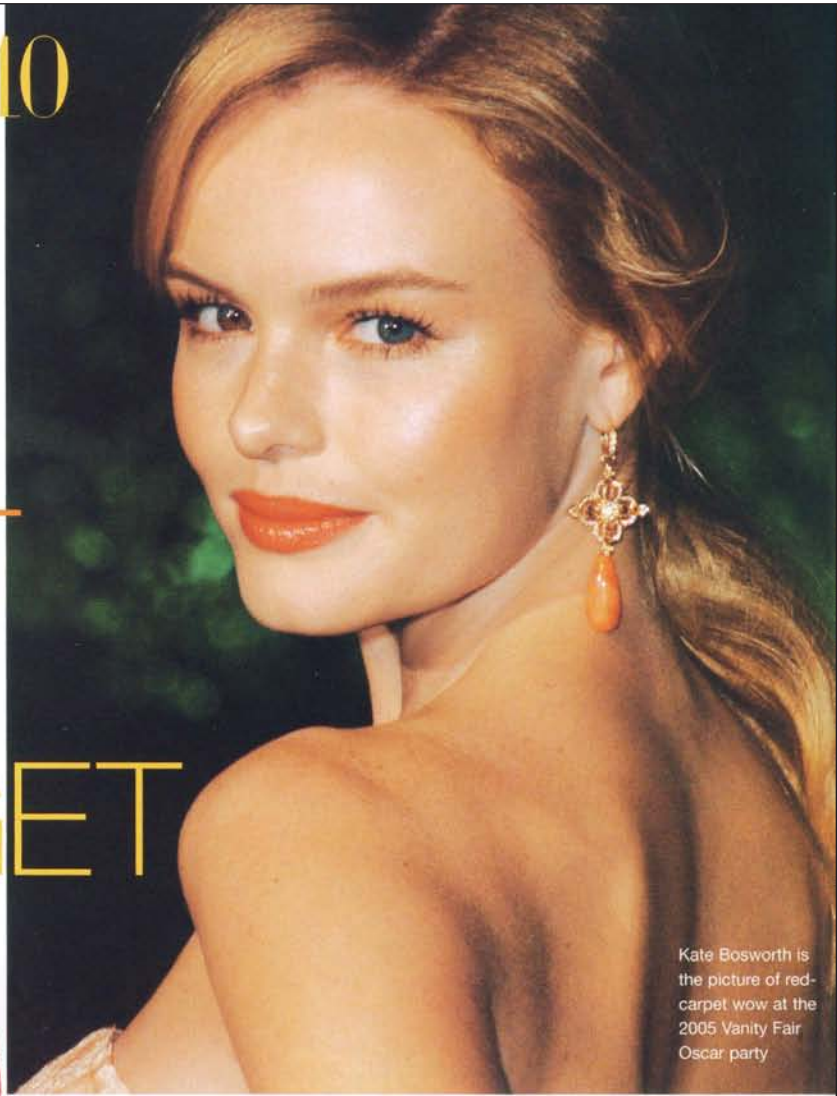


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You don't need to spend big bucks to get jet-set glam

A-LIST ON A BUDGET

1 Multitask like an A-lister. Cindy Crawford and Amanda Peet stock up on Kenra Platinum Silkening Gloss, 50 mL, \$15. The hair serum—formulated to reduce frizz and protect your hair from heat and UV rays—contains silk proteins, which hydrate your skin. Plus, you can smooth it on your hands and body or add a few drops to your bath. To make your cheeks, eyes and lips glisten, use Nars The Multiple in Riviera (above), \$46. The three-in-one cream formula is the perfect shade for summer nights.

2 Just arrived from Turtle Island Celebs get that bronzed, glistening skin from the hot spot du jour. Or do they? Lana Call, Estée Lauder premier makeup artist, says an all-over cream—like the one she credits the airbrush-tan look—can do the trick. Try Estée Lauder Go Bronze Plus Tinted Moisturizer, 150 mL, \$36. Exfoliate before you self-tan, and brush in vertically and horizontally to avoid streaking.

3 Red-carpet eyelashes Maybelline consulting makeup artist Troy Surratt says to-there eyelashes are a red-carpet must. Place individual false eyelashes at the outer corner of your eyes (choose ones slightly longer than your natural eyelashes), then brush on mascara. The finishing touch: perfect eyebrows. Surratt's universal tool, Maybelline Expert Eyes Twin Brow & Eye Pencils in Blonde, \$4.59, gives subtle definition to any arch.

4 Jet-set finish A perfect finish is the necessary final touch of a movie-star ensemble. DIY with a hydrating foot soak, a hydrating cream such as Got2b Soles Moisturizing & Healing Cream, 175 mL, \$8. Choose glittering jewelry (think ruby, rose quartz or amethyst) to complete the look.
