### SALMA HAYEK

"I'd use a little mousse to give the hair a bit of body and fullness," says Price, who also suggests using a large-barrel curling iron, then brushing out the curl. Try **Nexxus VitaTress Bodifying Mousse** or **Alterna Life Volumizing Spray Mousse**. "Finish the look with some kind of shine product," says Price. **Matrix ColorSmart Reflective Shine Spray** will do the trick.

## Belles of the Ball

### KEIRA KNIGHTLEY

Price suggests using a volumizer to add body to the hair before using a curling iron. "I'd spray each section with a little hairspray before ironing it," he says. Some to try include **Paul Mitchell Extra-Body Daily Boost**, **Redken Workforce 09** flexible volumizing spray and **Kenra Root Lifting Spray**.



### JUDI DENCH

"It looks like the ends have been round-brushed a little," says Price. "I'd apply some mousse, then use my fingers when blow-drying the hair." Try **René Furterer Anti-Dehydrating Volumizing Mousse**. For a bit more definition on the ends, Price suggests using a wax or pomade like **Retro Hair Twist & Shine Icing** or **Murad Moisturizing Pomade**.
